We really value the life long skill of swimming because of the huge physical, mental and social benefits that come with it. Our aim is to allow all children to be water confident and to swim 25m using a variety of different strokes by the end of their time with us. We have always swam from Years 3 to 6, with each year group attending lessons for half a term each. The school funds these sessions as swimming is part of the PE curriculum, and we ask for contributions towards the cost of the coach. However we are extremely short with these contributions across this academic year. As a school we cannot afford to pay for the shortfall in this. Therefore it is very unlikely that we will be able to offer swimming in the same way going forward from next year.
