Year 5 Maths Competition

On Tuesday after school, four amazing year 5 mathematicians; Poppy, Sid, Amber and Johannes, visited St Anne's Primary School in Godmanchester to take part in the Yr 5 Maths Challenge. It was an amazing experience with really fast paced and challenging questions in 4 different rounds. They had to estimate the number of dimples on a golf ball, in the estimation round (336 on average if you're interested), complete questions and problems covering all sorts of areas and use mathematical language to describe a picture to team members who didn't see it but had to recreate it. The children made us incredibly proud with their effort, teamwork and sheer enjoyment of the event. Well done!
