PE Kits



In September, we will no longer be asking the children to come to school in their PE kits on PE days. Instead, they will bring their kit and leave it school. This is for a number of reasons. Most importantly, this supports our safeguarding culture. It also means that if the children get wet and muddy during a PE lesson (as we are an all weather school), they don't need to sit in wet clothes. It has also been difficult during the cold weather for children to wear the appropriate indoor kit, which we must have for safety reasons. It is also 'one less thing to remember' especially when PE days need to change at short notice. We have also found that many younger children benefit from the opportunity to practise the skill of dressing themselves to develop their independence. This change will start in the new term.
