Forest School takes place each Friday.

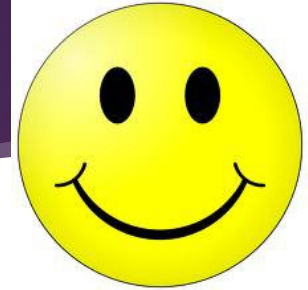
We wear school uniform to school on this day, but bring waterproof trousers and coat, or waterproof overalls in a bag to school that day.

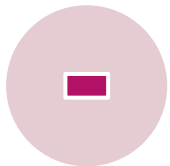

Our uniform

- ▶ Your school uniform:
- ▶ Grey or black trousers or grey pinafore/skirt, white polo shirt, school sweatshirt or cardigan, red and white checked summer dress. Black plimsoles for indoor use.

PE kit

- ▶ Coloured T-shirt in House colours (Information regarding this is in your pack)
- ▶ Black Shorts for Indoor PE
- ▶ Black tracksuit for outdoor PE
- ▶ Hair tied back and earrings removed or covered
- ▶ On PE days children come into school in their PE kit and stay in it all day.

Second hand uniform

- ▶ Fleeces are £4 (new is £12), jumpers and cardigans are £3 (new is £8.95).

What to bring

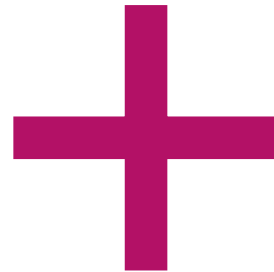
What is important.....

MARK-MAKING AND COUNTING

I enjoy making marks using lots of different things.
I am able to count sets of objects and enjoy number rhymes and counting games.

LISTENING TO OTHERS

I am able to sit still and listen for a short while.
I can follow simple instructions.

STORIES AND TALKING

I like to share stories and look at books.
I like to talk to others about the thing that interests me.
I like asking questions.

BEING ACTIVE

I enjoy playing outside.
I can run, climb, jump, skip, balance and hop.
I use different equipment e.g. balls, hoops and spades.

INDEPENDENCE

I can eat my lunch independently.
I am able to go to the toilet and wipe myself.
I can get dressed and undressed.

ROUTINES

I can leave my grown up with a quick goodbye.
I have regular early bedtime routine.
I have a good morning routine.

Sound out words and objects that you see together.

Recognise and write numbers to 10.
